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## **“INVITATION FOR NEGOTIATION” (Two Failed Biddings)**

### **“Supply and Delivery of ICT Supplies and Equipment for CCAT eLStudio”**

In view of the two (2) failed biddings, Cavite State University-CCAT Campus Bids and Award Committee (CvSU-CCAT BAC) invites interested bidders to participate in the Negotiated Procurement for the **Supply and Delivery of ICT Supplies and Equipment for CCAT eLStudio** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of *Three Million One Hundred Fifty Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Nine pesos and 26/100 (₱3,150,449.26)* in accordance with section 53.1 Two Failed Biddings as specified in the 2016 Revised Implement Rules Regulation of Republic Act 9184, other wise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

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Interested bidder shall submit the following documents in sealed envelopes, labeled as "Negotiated Document", with the title project name of the bidder, addressed of the bidder, and contact details of the bidder, addressed to the undersigned:

The Eligibility and Technical Documents will be composed of the following:

**Eligibility Documents and Technical Eligibility Documents**  
**(Envelope 1)**

- A. Valid PhilGEPS Registration Certificate (Platinum Membership) (all pages); or
- B. Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid; and
- C. Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided for in Sections 23.4.1.3 and 23.4.2.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents; and
- D. Original copy of Bid Security. If in the form of a Surety Bond, submit also a certification issued by the Insurance Commission; or Original copy of Notarized Bid Securing Declaration; and
- E. Conformity with the Technical Specifications, which may include production/delivery schedule, manpower requirements, and/or after-sales/parts, if applicable; and
- F. Original duly signed Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS);  
and if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative; or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.

**Financial Documents**

- A. The Supplier's audited financial statements, showing, among others, the Supplier's total and current assets and liabilities, stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission; and



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- B. The prospective bidder's computation of Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC); or A committed Line of Credit from a Universal or Commercial Bank in lieu of its NFCC computation.


**Financial Document (Envelope 2)**

- A. Original of duly signed and accomplished Financial Bid Form; and
- B. Original of duly signed and accomplished Price Schedule(s). Other documentary requirements under RA No. 9184 (as applicable)
- C. [For foreign bidders claiming by reason of their country's extension of reciprocal rights to Filipinos] Certification from the relevant government office of their country stating that Filipinos are allowed to participate in government procurement activities for the same item or product.
- D. Certification from the DTI if the Bidder claims preference as a Domestic Bidder or Domestic Entity.

First time bidder on this project is required to pay a non-refundable amount of Five Thousand Pesos (₱5,000.00) for the Bidding Documents

Cavite State University-CCAT Campus, Bids and Award Committee (BAC) reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
